As a member of the Greystone Kitchen Crew you will be responsible for feeding over 700 meals 3 times a day. We make most of our meals from scratch and try hard to have the best food and cleanest kitchen. The crew is divided into, groups, bakery, prep, cooks, frontline and dishroom. First year applicants will always be in the dish room before being moved into other areas. The days start early and finish late. The work is very hard and it is usually hot. You will be working and living very closely with your peers, with very little private time. The cabins can be crowded and sometimes the showers are cold.

So why would you want to work here?

Because when the summer is over not only will you have served more meals, played more games and made more new friends than you ever would at home, but you will also have the best summer of your life.

- Boys and girls are not allowed in each others cabins or alone with each other around camp.
- You will respect and obey your counselors at all times.
- Foul language, bad attitude and lazy work habits will not tolerated.
- Other rules will be covered during orientation
